



### Acceptable Forms of Identification for Motor Vehicle Transactions

*Reference: Minnesota Statutes, sections 168A.04, 171.06; Minnesota Rule 7410*

- Minnesota driver's license, identification (ID) card, or permit that is current or not expired more than one year.
- A driver's license, ID card, or permit from the following jurisdictions that is current or not expired for more than one year:
  - Another U.S. state
  - District of Columbia
  - Guam, Puerto Rico, or Virgin Islands
  - Canadian province or territory
- Certified copy of a birth certificate from a government bureau of vital statistics or board of health in the U.S., District of Columbia, Canada, Guam, Puerto Rico, or Virgin Islands. (A certificate of birth issued by a hospital or a baptismal certificate is not acceptable.)
- Certificate of Birth Abroad issued by the U.S. Department of State (FS-545 or DS-1350).
- Report of Birth Abroad of a U.S. citizen issued by a U.S. embassy (FS-240).
- Certified copy of an adoption certificate containing the full name and date of birth. Must be issued by a U.S. or Canadian court.
- Unexpired U.S. Department of Defense ID card (form DD-2).
- Valid, unexpired U.S. or Canadian passport.
- Valid, unexpired consular identification card, issued by a recognized consulate of a jurisdiction other than the United States.
- Valid, unexpired passport from another jurisdiction (other than the U.S. or Canada) with an unexpired I-94 form with the applicant's name, or an unexpired I-551 stamp.
- Certificate of Naturalization (N-550, N-570 or N-578).
- Certificate of Citizenship (N-560, N-561 or N-645).
- U.S. Citizen Identification card (1-179 or 1-197).
- Permanent Resident or Resident Alien card (1-551 or 1-151).
- Immigration and Naturalization Service issued Northern Mariana card (imprinted with "Northern Mariana").
- American Indian card (Form I-872) or Minnesota tribal identification card that meets the requirements of Minn. Stat., section 171.072.
- Unexpired Arrival and Departure form (1-94) without a valid passport but stamped "Refugee," with a photo affixed.
- Unexpired employment authorization document with a photo (1-688, I-688A, 1688B, or 1-766).
- Unexpired Re-entry Permit/Refugee Travel Document (1-571).
