MNDRIVE Information for Dealers

Are you ready for 2021?

Yellow handwritten 21-day resident permits and 31-day non-resident permits will be obsolete starting Jan. 1, 2021. You need to issue temporary registration permits through MNDRIVE, on the new paper, beginning in January.

To begin issuing permits through MNDRIVE you must:

- Set up a MNDRIVE account by submitting a records access agreement. Instructions are available on the DPS-DVS website at drive.mn.gov, select Partner Resources and click on [MNDRIVE](#).
- Purchase the new 21-day and 31-day permit paper from:

MNDRIVE lets you:

- Perform record queries on trade-in vehicles.
- Manage your dealer license online.
 - You can update license information and renew your license.
- Order dealer plates.
- File title notifications.
 - Held for resale, junk, etc.
- Issue 21-day and 31-day permits.
- Calculate title and registration fees.
- Establish vehicle record before your customer leaves your lot.
- Participate in the electronic vehicle title and registration (EVTR) program.
