

The Department of Public Safety Driver and Vehicle Services (DVS) division is **committed** to creating a **safe environment** for our **customers and staff.**

It is a crime to interfere with the work of a DVS employee. Minn. Stat. 609.50, Subd. 5.

THE FOLLOWING BEHAVIORS WILL NOT BE TOLERATED:

1. Unruly or disruptive behavior, including verbal harassment of staff or customers.
2. Obscene or abusive language, gestures or actions.
3. Interfering with services being delivered.
4. Failure to follow instructions of the staff.
5. Violent behavior, including conduct that endangers employees or customers, or damages state property.

You will be asked to leave the premises and law enforcement will be contacted if any of these behaviors occur.

Tennessee Notice: To the extent DVS has collected personal information you have submitted to DVS, it may disclose that personal information when it relates to public safety. The use of personal information relates to public safety if it concerns the physical safety or security of drivers, vehicles, pedestrians, or property. The personal information you provided is classified by 18 United States Code section 2721 and the Minnesota Government Data Practices Act, Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 13, and is subject to the disclosure in accordance with these laws. The information you provided may also be shared upon court order or provided to the state or legislative auditor.
